Rules and Regulations

1. All market sale rules and regulations apply to market goat class.
2. Required date of ownership for market animals, unless prior authorization from superintendent, is 90 days prior to the fair. Breeding stock minimum of 60 days prior to fair.
3. All goats must comply with health requirements.
4. All age divisions are encouraged to show.
5. No bucks allowed.
6. 4-H, FFA and Grange Market Grand Champion Goat must sell.
7. 4-H, FFA, Grange and Open Youth MUST have educational posters to display in barn.
8. Primary and Open Adults are encouraged to have some type of educational display and decorations.
9. Exhibitor may enter up to four entries per class *as long as* space allows.
10. Market animals must be born on or after January 1 of current year
11. Open Youth may only show miniature or dwarf breeds.
12. No bucks can be sold or shown in any class.
13. Market goats must be identified with scrappies tag. Must be noted on YQCA forms.
14. Market Class minimum weight for 60lbs. up to 110lbs. (*no light or heavy weight may market*)
15. All breeding stock must be checked in. All breeding must be accompanied with a haul slip stating point of origin, with exhibitor name way of contact, number of animals, animals personal id (tag, tattoo/scrapie) and herd identification. If you need help with obtaining one contact the Goat Superintendent.
16. All market goats must be fitted with a **"Terminal Chip"** (*uniformly clipped to 3/8" or less above the hocks and knees*) **PRIOR** to check in.
17. All dairy does two years old or older must have freshener for type classes.
18. All 4-H, FFA and Grange exhibitors must fit and show.
19. Goats must be bathed the day of fair prior to arriving. Can be washed at fair but should be avoided if possible.
20. All dairy breeds MUST be clipped according to breed characteristics **PRIOR** to check in. Except for kids under four months old, full body clipping is optional, but must be cleaned and fit properly.
Chain collar must be used during shows, no buckle or snap collars in the ring, show halters upon approval of superintendent.

Classes:

1. Doelings born on or after May 1st
2. Doelings born in April.
3. Doelings born in March.
4. Doelings born in January & February
Doelings born before January 1st and under two years old, never freshened

Junior Champion & Junior Reserve Champion

1. Does under two years old, in milk or freshened.
2. Does two years old and three years old, in milk or freshened.
3. Does four and five years old, in milk or freshened.
4. Senior Doe (doesn't have to be in milk greater than 5 years.)
5. Senior Doe Dry (aged does over 5)

Senior Champion & Senior Reserve

Best of Breed (*includes Senior Champion & Junior Champion Class*). All animals shown in group class must be owned and shown by same exhibitor. Each animal must be shown in individual classes to be eligible in group class.

1. Get of Sire, three does (sire named)
2. Produce of Dam, two does/the product of same dam, dam must be named.
3. Dam, in milk, and daughter
4. Three generations
5. Dairy Herd: Three does in milk (*one herd/exhibitor/breed*)
6. Breeders Herd: Four does bred by exhibitor, at least one in milk (*one herd per exhibitor in breed*)
7. Best Udder: Award only (*no cash/premium points*)
8. Companion/Pet (*Section C only, whether allowed*)
