Rules & Regulations

1. Required date of ownership for Market Steer is April 26, Breeding Beef is May 1.
2. A separate brand inspection slip for each steer must be submitted to the beef superintendent upon arrival.
3. ALL exhibitors must comply with the Livestock Rules and Regulations, Livestock Health Requirements, and Market Auction Rules and Regulations.
4. ALL beef must be registered with the superintendent on arrival at fairgrounds and shall not be removed until checked out by superintendent on Sunday morning.
5. Exhibitor must keep animal and stall well-groomed until close of fair on Saturday evening or forfeit all premiums.
6. If a carcass is found to contain drugs or tranquilizers by the federal inspector at the slaughter plant, the sale monies for that animal will be withheld from the exhibitor and returned to the buyer.
7. Steers must be dehorned (*healed and regrowth not to exceed 2 inches*) or naturally polled. Horned heifers may be shown in Fitting and Showing Classes only if their horns are weighted.
8. All cattle must be halter trained and the exhibitor must be able to handle the animal. All cattle must always be tied with a satisfactory neck rope in addition to a halter and rope in the barn until close of fair on Sunday.

3. Mature Cow Two females bred and owned by exhibitor.

4. Junior Bull Calf, calved after March 1st
5. Intermediate Bull Calf, calved January 1st – February 29th
6. Late Summer Bull Calf, calved November 1st – December 31st
7. Early Summer Bull Calf, calved September 1st – October 31st

RESERVE JUNIOR CHAMPION BULL

8. Late Summer Yearling Bull, calved July 1st – August 31st
9. Early Summer Yearling Bull, calved May 1st – June 30th
10. Late Junior Yearling Bull, calved March 1st – April 30th
11. Early Junior Yearling Bull, calved January 1st – February 29th

RESERVE CHAMPION BULL

22. Senior Yearling Bull, calved September 1st – October 31st
23. Late Two-Year-Old Bull, calved May 1st – August 31st
24. Early Two-Year-Old Bull, calved January 1st – April 30th SENIOR CHAMPION BULL

OTHER CLASSES

25. Pair of Bulls, two bulls bred and owned by exhibitor.
26. Get of Sire, four animals by one sire shown in the above classes, both sexes represented, owned or co owned by exhibitor.
27. Junior Get of Sire, three animals by one sire, both sexes represented, owned by exhibitor.
28. Produce of Dam, two animals either or both sexes, produced by one cow, bred and owned by exhibitor.
29. Pen of three to five feeder steers (limited to the first five exhibitors)
