#### Rules & Regulations

1. All cattle must be halter trained and the exhibitor must be able to handle the animal. All cattle must always be tied with a satisfactory neck rope in addition to a halter and rope in the barn until close of fair on Sunday.
2. Required date of ownership is Feb 1<sup>st</sup> for Dairy Springer Heifers, April 26 for Breeding Dairy.

Blue 50, Red 30, White 20

1. Springer Heifer and Dairy Bred sale-all breeds (Open to 4-H, FFA and Grange ONLY)
2. All entries must be bred. See rule #6 4H, FFA and Grange Heifer Sale Rules and Regulations

1. Junior Bull calf born after March 1<sup>st</sup> and over four months
2. Intermediate Bull calf born between December 1<sup>st</sup> (previous year) – February 28<sup>th</sup> (current year)
3. Senior Bull calf born between September 1<sup>st</sup> (previous year) – November 30<sup>th</sup>

#### Grand and Reserve Cow 4-18 Junior Champion & Junior Reserve

1. Spring Heifer calf born after March 1<sup>st</sup> and over four months.
2. Winter Heifer calf born between December 1<sup>st</sup> (previous year) – February 28<sup>th</sup> (current year)
3. Fall Heifer calf born between September 1<sup>st</sup> (previous year) – November 30<sup>th</sup>.
4. Summer Yearling Heifer born June 1<sup>st</sup> (previous year) – August 31<sup>st</sup> (previous year)
5. Spring Yearling Heifer born March 1<sup>st</sup> (previous year) – May 31<sup>st</sup> (previous year)
6. Winter Yearling Heifer born December 1<sup>st</sup> (two years prior) – February 28<sup>th</sup> (previous year)
7. Fall Yearling Heifer born September 1<sup>st</sup> (two years prior) – November 30<sup>th</sup> (two years prior)
8. Dry Cow three years & over born before September 1<sup>st</sup> (four years prior)
9. Junior two-year-old or Senior Yearling Milk born March 1<sup>st</sup> and August 31<sup>st</sup> (three years prior)

## Senior Champion & Reserve

### Senior Champion Female

(1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners of classes 13-19)

1. Senior two-year-old cow born September 1<sup>st</sup> (three years prior) – February 28<sup>th</sup> (two years prior)
2. Junior three-year-old cow born March 1<sup>st</sup> (three years prior) – August 31<sup>st</sup> (three years prior)
3. Senior three-year-old cow born September 1<sup>st</sup> (four years prior) – February 28<sup>th</sup> (three years prior)
4. Four-year-old cow born September 1<sup>st</sup> (five years prior) – August 31<sup>st</sup> (four years prior) Five-year-old cow born September 1<sup>st</sup> (six years prior) – August 31<sup>st</sup> (five years prior)
5. Aged cow six years & over born prior to August 31<sup>st</sup> (six years prior)
6. Jr. Best three females – three females shown in classes 04 and 10, all must be bred by exhibitor. One entry per exhibitor.
7. Best three females – three females shown in classes 04 and 18, at least one must have freshened, all bred by exhibitor and at least one owned by exhibitor. One entry per exhibitor.
8. Exhibitor's Herd – five females, all owned by exhibitor, two must have freshened, two unfreshened, one any age. One entry per exhibitor.
9. Produce of dam – two animals, either sex, any age from same dam. Dam to be named on entry form. Need not both be owned by exhibitor. One entry per exhibitor from same dam.
10. Daughter/Dam – two animals, a dam and her daughter (over four months), limited to one entry for each dam. Dam must be named on entry form. Animals may be owned by one or more exhibitors.
