Rules and Regulations

- 1. All exhibits must be preregistered by September 1st and in place by 8:00pm on Tuesday. The poultry superintendent will set up one test day with Sagehill Vet at the end of Aug, You may take your bird(s) to any vet of your choice, but test must be done within 90days of fair date.
 - a. Testing is at owners expense.
- 2. Bring your bird from 12:00pm to 8:00pm on Tuesday. All birds will be checked for health and lice/mites before being allowed in cages.
- 3. Each exhibitor must clean own cages before 8:00am and after 6:00pm each day.
- Each Exhibitor must always provide food and water their animal. The poultry barn will provide feed and feed/water containers for each bird.
- Animals observed without food and/or water for extended periods of time will forfeit all premium points and be pulled from sale line up upon investigation by the ethics committee.
- Exhibitors must keep all exhibits well groomed, fed, and clean until the close of fair. NO animals may be removed before fair closing.

- Each exhibitor must sign up for barn duty according to the superintendent's instructions. All children under 12 years old need an adult with them for barn duty.
- 8. An animal showing symptoms of disease, or external/internal parasites of any kind will NOTbe allowed to remain in the barn. Exhibitors will be required to take animal home
- Each animal or exhibitor shall be placed according to the decision of the judge and such placing shall be final. Exhibitors interfering with a judge will forfeit premiums. ALL JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
- 10. Exhibitors must own all the poultry they exhibit. Exhibitors are to show their own animals for judging unless excused by the superintendent.
- 11. Any exhibit left in the building not claimed within 12 hours of close of fair will be disposed of at the discretion of building superintendent.
- 12. All animals entered at owner's own risk and the Othello Fair will not be responsible for the entries, though all due care will be used to protect them.

- 13. All 4-H, FFA, Grange and Open Youth members will be judged on herdsman ship and be required to decorate their club cages. (Rules are printed under herdsman ship contest.)
- 14. Limit two entries per breed or division. (i.e., two blue quail cockerels or two white crested polish pullets); NOT to exceed ten entries total. Substitutions are allowed only in same breed class, variety and lot as originally entered.
- 15. Cages will be assigned by the superintendent on a first come, first served basis with 4-H and FFA given priority.
- **16.** Open Adult and Open Youth will be judged together.
- **17.** All market animals must be born after January 1st

Please make sure you dust your birds 14 days prior to the fair. Birds showing signs of mite/lice infestations will be sent home.
