- Each Exhibitor must always provide food and water their animal.
- Animals observed without food and/or water for extended periods of time will forfeit all premium points and be pulled from sale line up upon investigation by the ethics committee.
- Exhibitors must keep all exhibits well groomed, fed, and clean until the close of fair. NO animals may be removed before fair closing.
- Each exhibitor must sign up for barn duty according to superintendent's instructions.
 All children under 12 years old need an adult with them for

- 8. An animal showing symptoms of disease, or external/internal parasites of any kind will NOT be allowed to remain in the barn. Exhibitors will be required to take animal home.
- 9. Each animal or exhibitor shall be placed according to the decision of the judge and such placing shall be final.
